



Historic Preservation Awards Program Nomination Form

The presentation of awards began in 1979 and has been an annual event ever since. After reviewing the nominations, the GLC determines the type of recognition that is awarded based upon the historical correctness, quality or degree of difficulty of the project or efforts and overall aesthetic contribution. There are currently three types of awards: a Preservation Award for Voluntary Efforts in Restoration (P.A.V.E.R.), a specifically designed Certificate of Recognition and also a Letter of Recognition. Projects must be completed to be eligible for recognition.

2. Properties may be nominated for one of the following categories: (unless otherwise noted, structures must be at least 50 years old)
 - Preservation.** This includes buildings that have been kept in their original architectural style and are being used for their original purpose.
 - Restoration.** Properties that have been restored to their original style or appearance.
 - Sympathetic Addition.** Construction of an addition to an existing structure that is consistent with the original architectural style of the property.
 - Compatible New Construction.** This category may include structures less than 50 years old. Any new structure that is consistent with the original architectural style of the neighborhood or that utilizes historic materials and techniques.
 - Leadership.** Any individual or group exhibiting significant local leadership or implementing a successful program in historic preservation is also eligible for recognition.
