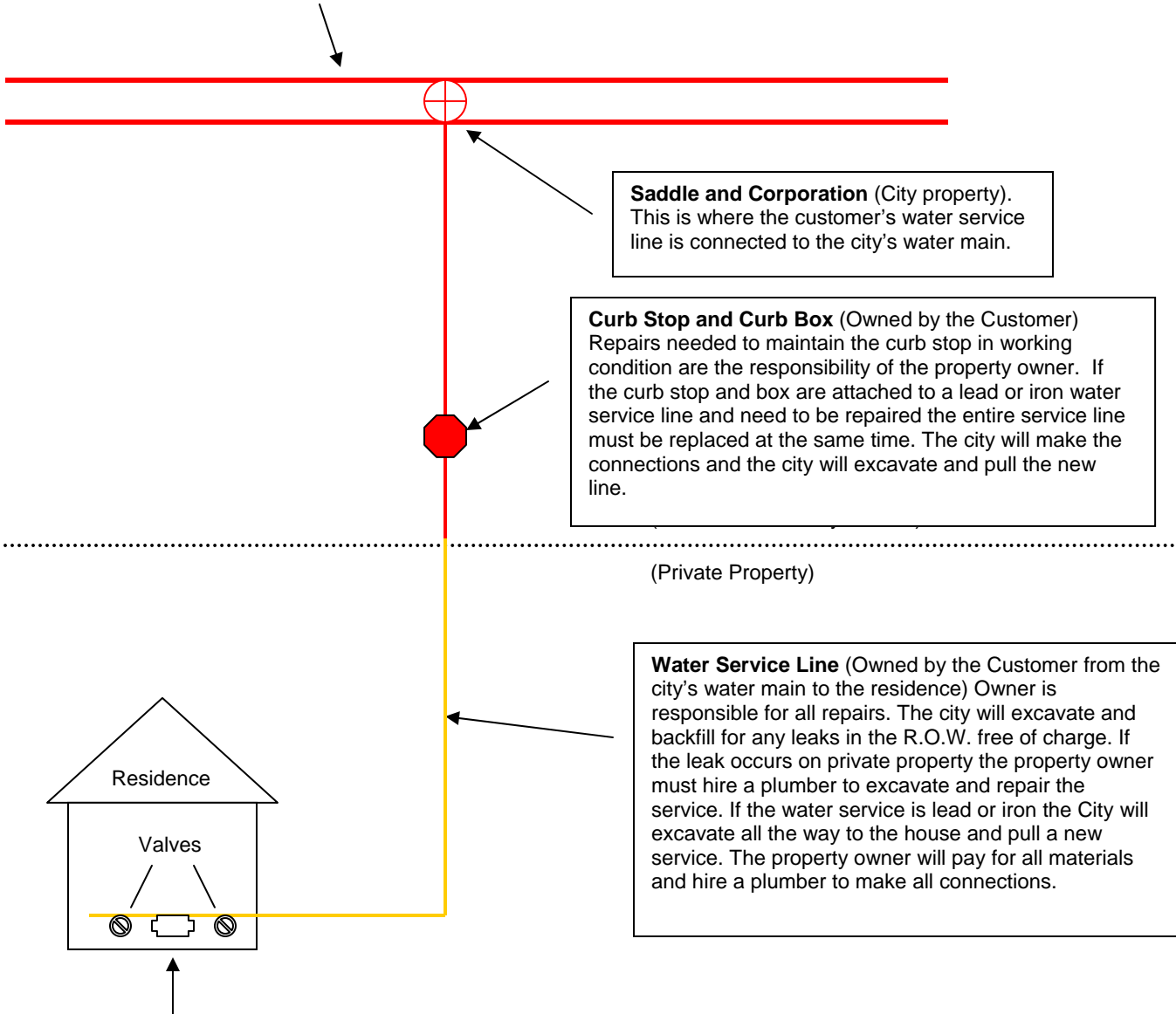


WATER SERVICE LINE AND FIRE SERVICE LINE CUSTOMER AND CITY RESPONSIBILITIES

City Water Main, (City Property) located in the street or terrace

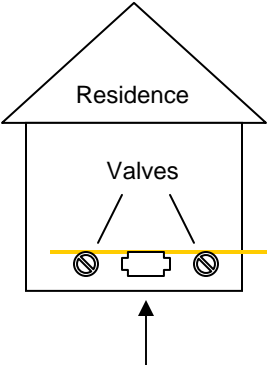


Saddle and Corporation (City property). This is where the customer's water service line is connected to the city's water main.

Curb Stop and Curb Box (Owned by the Customer) Repairs needed to maintain the curb stop in working condition are the responsibility of the property owner. If the curb stop and box are attached to a lead or iron water service line and need to be repaired the entire service line must be replaced at the same time. The city will make the connections and the city will excavate and pull the new line.


(Private Property)


Water Service Line (Owned by the Customer from the city's water main to the residence) Owner is responsible for all repairs. The city will excavate and backfill for any leaks in the R.O.W. free of charge. If the leak occurs on private property the property owner must hire a plumber to excavate and repair the service. If the water service is lead or iron the City will excavate all the way to the house and pull a new service. The property owner will pay for all materials and hire a plumber to make all connections.



Water Meter & Connections – City will furnish only 3/4" & 5/8" meters, the city will repair these meters free of charge. However, the customer will be charged for the cost of a new meter if the meter should become frozen or is tampered with by the customer.

Valves – Property owner is responsibility for all valves and plumbing inside the residence. The city will shut the water off at the curb stop free of charge in any emergency situation Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 4:30 pm; there is a \$25 charge for any non emergency service requests. After hours service requests will be charged a \$60 call out fee.

 City excavates, repairs and connects. Property owner pays for materials.

 Owner must hire someone to excavate and repair unless this is a lead or iron service, then the City will dig and pull a new service and the customer's plumber will connect the service to the residence.

- NOTES:**
- 1) In all instances that a repair is made by the City on a water service line, the property owner will be responsible for paying for all materials.
 - 2) In all instances that a property owner hires a plumber for repairs the property owner will be responsible for paying for all materials and the cost of the plumber.
