

EMERGENCY ORDER

I, John T. Pritchard, in my capacity as the Mayor and Liquor Commissioner for the City of Galesburg, Illinois, and pursuant to authority granted me in Special Ordinance 20-596, entitled "Emergency powers," do hereby order the following:

All businesses currently holding the following liquor licenses: Class A1, Class D, Class F, and Class L, that permits that license holder to sell or serve alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises, within the City limits of the City of Galesburg, shall be allowed by virtue of this order to do the following:

Effective immediately, all liquor license holders with a Class A1 or Class D, Class F, and Class L license will be able to sell packaged alcohol for off premise consumption only. The license requirement for off premise sales from the State of Illinois and the City of Galesburg will be temporarily waived.

On-Premise Only Retailers with carry out or curbside privileges shall remain effective until the termination of a health emergency by State officials. License holders will be strictly held to their license on-premises only privilege once the health emergency is lifted.

Retailers selling alcoholic liquor for off-premise consumption shall abide by all laws, rules and policies established by Executive Order 2020-07, the Illinois Liquor Control Commission Compliance Directive for local liquor control commissioners dated March 19, 2020. This is regarding rules, local ordinances and policies for packaged sales or "to go" sales.

This Emergency Order does not include any license holder with a Class A2 license (gaming parlors).

The purchase of any package liquor must be by carry out or pick up only. Sales will not be allowed by delivery or drive-thru FOR ANY LIQUOR LICENSE HOLDER IN THE CITY OF GALESBURG. Customers may not congregate or consume the alcohol on premises.

If the Galesburg Police Department determines that the liquor establishment has violated this order, the police have the authority to order that establishment to close until further notice or until the termination of this Order.
