Lifeguard

The City of Galesburg seeks qualified applicants to fill part-time Lifeguard positions in the Department of Parks and Recreation. Lifeguards work a varied schedule during the week and are paid \$8.40 per hour. This is an ideal position for high school or college students, and adults seeking additional employment.

Essential Duties of the Position

- Responsible for the overall safety of patrons using City facilities.
- Enforces rules and regulations, prevents accidents and responds to emergencies.
- Performs lifeguard surveillance, assists, rescues, and has decision-making skills.
- Must possess American Red Cross Lifeguard certifications (see below).
- Assists with water safety education, swim lessons and special events.
- Performs daily duties to include: completing necessary reports, recordkeeping, cleaning and other duties as may be assigned.

Minimum Requirements

- Applicants must possess:
 - American Red Cross Lifeguarding certificate
 - First Aid certificate
 - CPR for the Professional Rescuer
 - AED certificate(Note that certification classes are available through the City)
- A Water Safety Instructor certification is desirable.

Required Skill and Ability

- The successful applicant must possess the ability to:
 - Read, write and understand the English language.
 - Read, interpret and apply policies and procedures, and follow instructions.
 - Comply with all City and Departmental safety rules and regulations.
 - Establish and maintain positive relationships with the public and co-workers.
 - Perform moderate recreational activity in an outdoor environment.
